The Level 7 course took the shape of several workshops, which acted as the foundation for a significant body of self-directed learning. There was a great deal of research to undertake, a lot of theory to learn, and a lot of self-reflection using the workshop inputs. The assessments mostly took the form of study workbooks. with seven pieces of work to submit - each comprising of around 10,000 words related to a specific topic, including: developing the client relationship, analysing support needs, accessing different forms of business and enterprise support, developing skills as a Business Support Professional, and reflecting upon your own knowledge, skills and learning. There were also practical assessments that were tailored to your specific job role. Zoe says: "Some people are out and about with clients in their job role, but in my position you are mainly dealing with clients on the phone. so there were observational assessments where somehody listened in to phone conversations and assessed how I dealt with different remember that you're being assessed on elements of your role that you've been doing for a long time. Achieving the qualification at the end really does make you feel confident that you're doing a great job.
